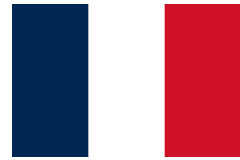

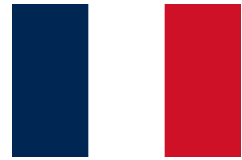
The United Kingdom of Great Britain And Northern Ireland is intent on ensuring the future generations will have something ours never had; a safe, peaceful, and prosperous world. Today we come together as a global community and are focused on creating a better world for all, as well as improving the socio-economic progress of other countries. However, we must emphasize the need for preserving the political connections and cooperation among countries in order to find cohesive solutions to problems in today's world of growing anti-globalization, and intense nationalism.

Now let's ask ourselves what these problems are. In the United Kingdom's view, escalation of tensions across the global hotspots is one of the most crucial issues. Although recently overshadowed by Hamas attack on Israel, we must remember that there are other areas globally, where tensions remain present and pose a security threat to the global community. Another important problem we face is the decline of human rights globally, especially in the less-developed nations and areas. Lastly, we would like to emphasize the need to protect and ensure that our heritage is preserved and that we don't forget the past, while taking the lessons history has taught us and using them to ensure ourselves a better future.

As mentioned, we have created a humanitarian crisis which has become a time bomb, and it must be disarmed quickly.
